Do I need a power plug adapter in the Dominican Republic?

In the Dominican Republic, they use power sockets (outlets) of type A and B, like in the United States. You need a power plug adapter in the Dominican Republic for sockets type A. Sockets type B can fit your plugs, but may not always be available locally. We don't sell power plug adapters.

Does Dominican Republic have power outlets?

In Dominican Republic, they use power outlets and plugs of type A and type B. The voltage is 110 V, and the frequency is 60 Hz. You will need an adapter for type A power outlets in Dominican Republic. Do power plugs from USA fit into Dominican Republic outlets? In Dominican Republic, power outlets are of type A and B, similar to USA.

What type of plug is used in Dominica?

The power plug and outlets used in Dominica are the types D and G plugs. The type D plug has three round pins arranged in a triangular pattern. The type G plug has three rectangular pins arranged in a triangular pattern. What is the voltage and frequency in Dominica? The standard voltage and frequency in Dominica is 230 V and 50 Hz.

What type of outlet does Dominican Republic use?

Dominican Republic uses Type A and B outlets with 110V and 60Hz. Travelers from USA need a power plug adapter but no voltage converter.

Does Dominican Republic need a voltage converter?
