Should I replace my roof with solar tiles?

They are individually attached to frames and brackets and sit on top of the roof, whereas solar tiles are built as part of the roof, often a section of the roof. Both work similarly in that they use solar cells, convert the sun's energy into electricity and power the home, however when you dig a little deeper, the differences are noticeable.

Are solar roof tiles worth it?

Solar roof tiles are still capable of producing as much electricity as a traditional solar panel system, but to achieve this you may have to cover your entire roof with them - and this comes with a very hefty price tag.

What are solar roof tiles?

Solar roof tiles, also known as solar slates or solar shingles, are made to look a lot like normal roof tiles, except they also contain photovoltaic (PV) cells and can generate electricity.
