What are Senegal's top 10 exports?

Senegal's top 10 exports generated almost four-fifths (78.4%) of the overall value of its global shipments. The metals iron and steel represent the fastest grower among the top 10 export categories, up by 22.7% from 2022 to 2023. In second place for improving export sales was the salt, sulphur, stone and cement product category via a 22.3% advance.

What are the top exports of Senegal in 2023?

In 2023, the top exports of Senegal were Gold (\$1.07B), Refined Petroleum (\$844M), Phosphoric Acid (\$497M), Non-fillet Frozen Fish (\$284M), and Cement (\$178M). The top destinations were Mali (\$1.22B), India (\$681M), Switzerland (\$625M), China (\$310M), and United Arab Emirates (\$251M).

What products are imported from Senegal?

"Other products," include computer and electronic products, plastics and rubber products and fabricated metal products. The top five imports from Senegal were food products (38 percent), miscellaneous commodities (28 percent), minerals and ores (24 percent), chemicals (6 percent), and "other products" (4 percent).

What products does Senegal export under AGOA?

The products that Senegal exports under AGOA include animal products (cows, meat, leather and skins), oilseed products (sesame, groundnuts, nuts and shea butter, cashew nuts), horticultural products (mangoes, onions), cereals, mining products, handicrafts, cotton, textile products and clothing.

How much money does Senegal export?

During the last five reported years, the exports of Senegal have increased by \$944M from \$4.78B in 2018 to \$5.72B in 2023. The most recent exports are led by Gold (\$1.07B), Refined Petroleum (\$844M), Phosphoric Acid (\$497M), Non-fillet Frozen Fish (\$284M), and Cement (\$178M).

What was the US trade surplus with Senegal in 2021?

The U.S. trade surplus with Senegal was \$148 million in 2021. As shown in the chart below, the top five U.S. exports to Senegal in 2021 were "other products" (32 percent), transportation equipment (24 percent), oil and gas (18 percent), used or secondhand merchandise (15 percent), and chemicals (11 percent).

Senegal's installed capacity is presently 1,431 megawatts (MW). Major infrastructure projects include the development of a new city in Diamniadio near Dakar, healthcare and hospital upgrades, toll road development, electrical power line and distribution upgrades, fiber optic cable landings and extensions, and carrier-neutral datacenters.
